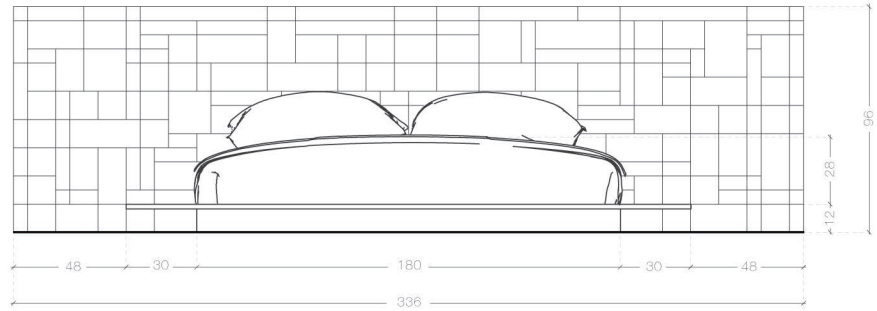
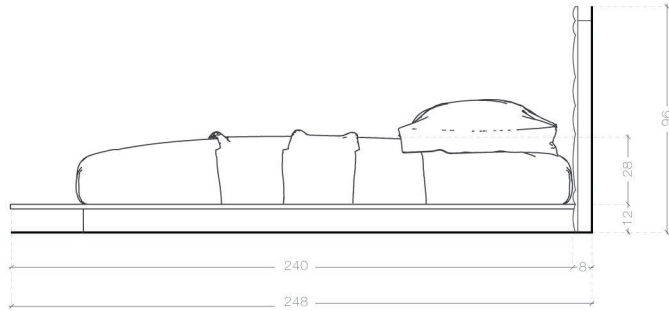
*If a tree falls in a forest and no one is around to hear it does it make a sound?*

The **Echo bed** is meant to be an important reminder of the trees that are often destroyed by severe storms due to climate changes we cause.

The *Echo bed* frame is made up of wooden planks from storms-damaged trees treated and finished with the **Shou Sugi Ban & Yakisugi**: this traditional Japanese technique of wood preservation allows us to use all the destroyed tree trunks without worry about the aesthetic conditions by giving them a second life. By slightly charring the surface of the wood, the planks turn black and become water-proof, more durable and well protected against insects.

The *Echo* headboard is related again to the trees, their previous life and their memory for the next future; based on **Piet Mondrian's Tree Evolution** paintings the grey leather headboard's design composition is made by horizontal / vertical seams reproducing the well known Dutch artist' style.



**Hidden structure**

The 6 cm deep wooden wall structure leaves 6 cm of space along the perimeter for the lights

**Upholstered headboard**

The leather seams have been designed to reproduce the Piet Mondrian's famous pattern art

**Mattress**

The Elite mattress is 180x200 cm and its deep is 28 cm to enhance the suspension effect

**Planks frame**

The wooden planks are treated by the Shou Sugi Ban technique and their thickness is 2 cm

**Wooden base**

The basement is made by recycled wood and its dimension is 216x192 cm with 10 cm high
